

**MINUTES  
CITY OF LAKE WORTH  
CITY COMMISSION  
WORK SESSION  
AUGUST 25, 2016 – 6:00 PM**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Triolo on the above date at 6:00 PM in the City Commission Chamber, located at 7 North Dixie Highway, Lake Worth, Florida.

**1. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Mayor Pam Triolo; Vice Mayor Scott Maxwell; and Commissioners Christopher McVoy, Andy Amoroso, and Ryan Maier. Also present were City Manager Michael Bornstein, City Attorney Glen Torcivia, and Deputy City Clerk Melissa Ann Coyne.

**2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:**

The pledge of allegiance was led by Commissioner Ryan Maier.

**3. UPDATES/FUTURE ACTION/DIRECTION:**

**A. Discuss Neighborhood Streets Projects:**

Brent Whitfield, ADA Engineering, gave a presentation regarding pavement management planning and stated that it would cost \$120 million to replace the streets in Lake Worth. He explained how ADA Engineering had examined every street in 2013 and determined that their Pavement Condition Index (PCI) was 74.7 with 10% of the streets being in poor condition. He said asphalt degraded over time and currently, the PCI had dropped from 74.7 in 2013 to 68.1 in 2016 with 22% of the streets in poor condition.

Lengthy discussion ensued regarding funding options for road maintenance and repair.

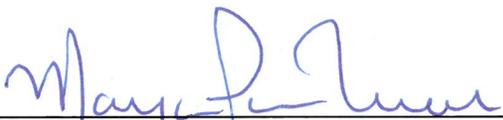
Comments/requests summaries:

1. Mr. Whitfield commented that the program to repair roadways would allow the City to have a maintenance plan rather than requiring large scale repairs. He said a properly maintained road would outlast a 30-year bond.
2. Mayor Triolo commented that the foundation underneath the roads was not properly constructed, which caused potholes. After the 2014 bond referendum failed, residents asked how their roads would be fixed. She explained that, due to a lack of funds, the roads were neglected. She stated that foundations needed to be fixed or the roadways would

continue to fall apart.
