EXECUTIVE BRIEF

TITLE:

Sixth Amendment to the Agreement with Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office.

SUMMARY:

The City and PBSO entered into a law enforcement service agreement on October 1, 2008. This amendment would add five (5) deputy sheriffs and one (1) crossing guard and increase the annual payment from \$12,221,000.00 to \$13,094,701.00.

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION:

The City and PBSO entered into a law enforcement service agreement on October 1, 2008. This amendment would add five (5) deputy sheriffs and one (1) crossing guard and increase the annual payment from \$12,221,000.00 to \$13,094,701.00.

SIXTH ADDENDUM TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE AGREEMENT
SHERIFF RIC L. BRADSHAW AND THE CITY OF LAKE WORTH

This Sixth Addendum to the Law Enforcement Service Agreement is made by and between The City of Lake Worth (hereinafter referred to as "City"), located in Palm Beach County, and Ric L. Bradshaw, Sheriff of Palm Beach County, Florida (hereinafter referred to as "Sheriff"). The City and the Sheriff shall hereinafter be referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, the Parties executed a Law Enforcement Service Agreement effective October 01, 2008, a First Addendum effective October 01, 2009, a Second Addendum effective October 01, 2010, a Third Addendum October 01, 2011, a Fourth Addendum October 01, 2013, and a Fifth Addendum October 01, 2015, (the "Agreement"), by which the Sheriff agreed to perform law enforcement services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to adjust the level of service by the addition of five (5) Deputy Sheriff and one (1) Crossing Guard, set forth the consideration for the contract term October 01, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is agreed upon as follows:

1. The level of service has been modified by the addition of five (5) Deputy Sheriff, and one (1) Crossing Guard. The level of service and allocations for the City are reflected in revised Exhibit A, attached and incorporated as if fully stated herein. Revised Exhibit A hereby replaces former Exhibit A to the Agreement and is effective October 01, 2016.
2. Article 6, Section 6.1 of the Law Enforcement Service Agreement is amended as to the total amount due for services for the period beginning October 01, 2016 through September 30, 2017 as follows: The total amount due for the annual period referenced above shall be \$13,094,701.00. Monthly payments shall be \$1,091,225.08. The last monthly payment shall be \$1,091,225.12
3. In all other respects and unless otherwise stated, the terms and conditions of the Agreement, which includes prior Addendums, shall continue unchanged and in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have executed this Addendum to the Agreement as of the last date all signatures below are affixed.
