

## Handicapped Individuals

A handicapped person who possesses a handicapped placard or handicapped license plate may park in any metered parking space or timed zone and for FREE for 4 hours. Please remember that the handicapped placard, permit, or plate must be properly displayed.

Information on How to Park & Pay



## How to Park and Pay

1. Park your vehicle in one of the metered spaces.  
Make sure to remember your parking space number.  
You will need it.
2. Locate any Parking Meter. Look for the symbol: 
3. Enter your parking space number.
4. Select the amount of parking time you require.
5. Choose the method of payment – credit card or coins. MasterCard & Visa accepted.  
Keep your receipt with you in event you wish to extend your time. You are not required to display the receipt on your vehicle dash.
6. Collect your receipt and you are on your way!

## Need to Add More Time?

- NOTE: The Parking Session Must Expire Before Time May Be Added.
- Go to any parking meter location in the City;
- Enter your parking space number;
- Select the amount of additional parking time;
- Make a payment.

## Resident Beach Decals

For resident and seasonal decals, look for the signs or ground markings. There are 24 dedicated spaces on the first row of the lower lot and 26 on the North side lots.

## How Long May I Park?

You may park for as long as you wish, however the meters will only allow for the following time frames.

### Parking Meter Expiration Time Limits Per Session

- At the Beach  
6 Hour Maximum Limit Per Session
- Parkmobile  
8 Hour Maximum Limit Per Session
- At Bryant Park Boat Ramp | 5 Day Maximum  
There is no backing into spaces in any casino lot.
